3. **REPORT FORMS**

3. **PARENTAL CONSULTATIONS WITH TEACHERS**  
Parents are advised to utilize break-time from 10.00 a.m to 10.30 a.m on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays to come and consult with teachers. Visits should be by appointment.

5. **SCHOOL FEES**  
No pupil will be allowed in school if they have not cleared fees and at least half of the first term fees must be paid. Fees to be paid through BANK OF AFRICA ACCOUNT NO.01185620100. Parents may also pay through our M-pesa pay bill NO.786659. For the account number write your child's admission number and first name.
6. **SCHOOL UNIFORM**  
Kindly ensure that your child reports to school in correct uniform. Girls' dresses must be loose fitting and fall below their knees. White cotton *Jalbab's* must reach the hips. Only low heeled black schools shoes with lace/buckles and bottles green sweaters and pullovers are allowed. Boys' trousers must not be tight (piped). Boys may be allowed to put on white *Kanzus* and prescribed sportswear over the weekend. All pupils must report with at least 3 pairs of labeled uniform. Any other footwear and wrong clothes will be confiscated. Only one level short hair will be allowed in school for boys.
7. **COVID 19 GUIDELINES**  
The school is compliant with Covid 19 protocols which have been put in place to mitigate instances of contracting the virus. Parents must avail enough masks, a prayer mat and approved sanitizers to their children/wards. Join us in guiding our students on exercising care and taking precautions during this challenging period. As per regulation from the Ministry of Education casual visits to the school are prohibited.


