### 7. SCHOOL UNIFORM

Kindly ensure that your child reports to school in correct uniform. Girls' dresses must be loose fitting and fall below their knees. White cotton jalbabs must reach the hips. Only low heeled black school shoes with lace/buckles, white socks and bottle green sweaters and pullovers are allowed.

Boys' trousers must not be tight (piped). Boys may be allowed to put on white Kanzus and prescribed sportswear over the weekend. All pupils must report with at least 3 pairs of labelled uniform. Any other footwear and wrong clothes will be confiscated and donated to orphanages. Only level one short hair will be allowed in school for boys.

#### 5. SCHOOL FEES

Due to a sharp increase in prices of commodities there is **an increase in fees for day/boarding** students as per **Appendix A and B**. This is effective from January 2024.

This activity took place on the 22nd of September, 2023. It was held in the school hall from 10.30a.m. to 12.30p.m. All form one students were in attendance together with their class teachers.

The event was organized and hosted by the Career Unit. #### 10. PLACEMENT OF STUDENTS TO UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES 2024

Following recent developments which include a new funding model for tertiary education, applicants are required to make choices based on cost per programme as published in the KUCCPS online application systems.

The application for placement to universities and colleges will commence after release of KCSE results and declaration of programmes, capacities and program costs in various institutions.

Applications will henceforth be done by parents or guardians and applicants. Centre/School application will NOT be available. However, guidance will be provided through the careers department.

### **TIPS FOR PARENTS**

Identity formation is a key process for adolescents' growth. Identity is reflected in how a person behaves/ acts in different situations and contexts. It involves integrations of one's self understanding, goals, values and behavior in influencing choices a young person makes in life.

Young people who blindly follow others are mostly distracted from their own development and may embrace undesirable habits.

It is necessary for parents to work with teachers closely to provide opportunities that will enhance growth and monitoring of young adults who will be psychologically healthier and hence more focused in their journey in adulthood.
