HOLIDAY TIPS FOR PARENTS

As your child reports home for holidays, it is important to have conversations about their academic progress. Any concerns noted ought to be communicated to the subject teacher via the class teacher. A school visit should be organized strictly through an appointment at a convenient time during the first two weeks of the next term.

Open days must be attended by parents and official guardians. Casual representation by youngsters and farfetched friends and relatives is not acceptable as it yields no benefit.

You must also find out the working habits of your child/ward. This includes the study schedule that they follow study habits such as intensive reading for 20-30 minutes session, writing brief notes, attempting questions topic wise and a few guidelines on studying effectively. Use of phone/social media must be controlled by the parent.

Given the demands of our curriculum it is important for your child to have a working holiday. This means they must have some time to interact with their studies. Any supplementary materials should be purchased with guidance of the teacher. Some web generated notes and papers may be ineffective or irrelevant.
